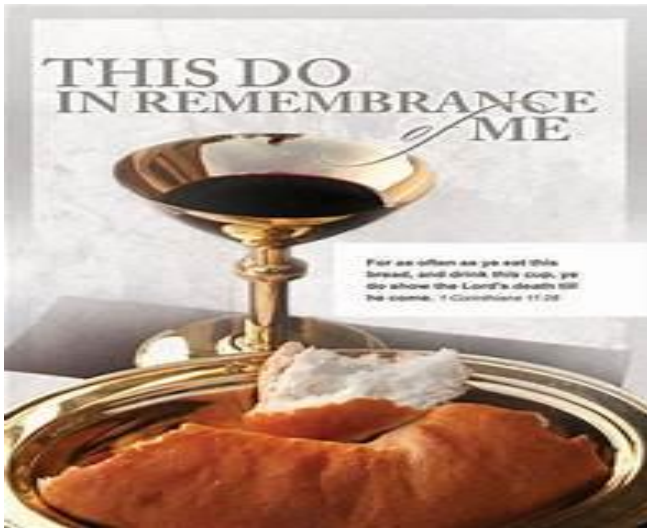

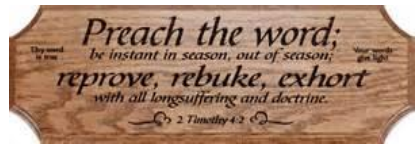

Church Covenant

Having been led, as we believe, by the spirit of God, to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Savior. And on the profession of our faith, having been baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, we do now, in the presence of God, angels, and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another, as one body in Christ.

We also engage to maintain family and secret devotions; to religiously educate our children; to seek the salvation of our kindred and acquaintances; to walk circumspectly in the world; to be just in our dealings, faithful in our engagements, and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid all tattling, backbiting, and excessive anger; and to be zealous in our efforts to advance the kingdom of our Savior.

We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rules of our Savior to secure it without delay.

We moreover engage that when we remove from this place we will, as soon as possible, unite with some other church, where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.

The Lord's Supper
(I Corinthians 11: 23-26)

Minister: The Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said,

Congregation: Take eat; this is My body which is broken for you; this do **in remembrance of Me.**

Minister: In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, this cup is the new covenant in My blood.

Congregation: This do, as often as you drink it, **in remembrance of Me.**

Minister: For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, **you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes."**
